Terms and Conditions

1) Delivery

The Manufacturer will make available the Boat, plus any extras to the Purchaser at the manufacturer's premises, as noted on page 2 of this agreement or so soon thereafter as is reasonably possible, at which time, the Purchaser will immediately take and accept Delivery of the Boat.

2) Liability

- 1) The Manufacturer shall not be liable for any damage or loss to the Purchaser, whether direct or consequential, if that damage or loss arises out of:
 - a) Non-delivery; and/or
 - b) Delay in delivery of the Boat by or on behalf of the Manufacturer;
- 2) Under no circumstances shall the Manufacturer be liable to any person for any consequential damage or loss suffered by that person, insofar as that consequential damage or loss exceeds 1% of the Total Price.

3) Passing of Title

Risk, Title, ownership, possession and the right to possession of the Boat shall only pass to the Purchaser:

- 1) In the case of a cash purchase, when the Purchaser has:
- a) Paid any balance to be paid in full, to the Manufacturer by bank cheque, cash, eftpos or receipt by the Manufacturer of cleared funds if payment made electronically; or
- 2) In the case of a purchase on Hire Purchase terms, when the Purchaser has:
 - a) Executed all Hire Purchase documents required to be executed; and
- b) Made payment to the Manufacturer in full.

4) Consumer Guarantees Act

Nothing in this Agreement shall limit the Purchaser's rights under the Consumer Guarantees Act ("Act"). If any provision of this Agreement is inconsistent with the Act's provisions, then to the extent of that inconsistency only, the Act shall prevail. Otherwise, the terms of this Agreement shall determine all rights and duties of the parties in respect of this Agreement.

5) Warranty

In addition to any rights available to the Purchaser under the Act, upon the passing of title in the Boat from the Manufacturer to the Purchaser under this Agreement, the Purchaser shall be entitled to any standard manufacturer's warranty on the Chattels (subject to the terms of that warranty) to which the Manufacturer would otherwise be entitled.

6) Deposit, Cancellation, Settlement

- 1) If the Purchaser fails to pay the deposit by the deposit date, the Manufacturer may, at the Manufacturer's absolute discretion, and at any stage after the deposit date, cancel this agreement.
- 2) Once the deposit is paid the sale becomes unconditional.
- 3) Payment of the balance of the purchase price becomes due on settlement date. If the Purchaser does not pay on settlement date, the Manufacturer may elect to cancel the agreement and retain the deposit.
